Fabric Requirements

- 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards Burgundy marble
- 2 $\frac{1}{3}$ yards Tan marble
- 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards Blue marble
- 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards Cream marble

Block 1 Make 17 blocks

9" blocks finished

4-patch -68 needed

Cut strips of blue 2" x wof

Cut strips of tan 2" x wof

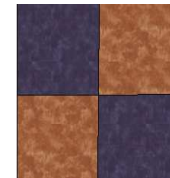
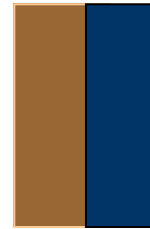
Sew 1 tan and 1 blue strip together.

Press seams toward the dark.

Cut 2" sections

Sew 2 sections together to make the

4-patch block. Refer to the picture for block placement.



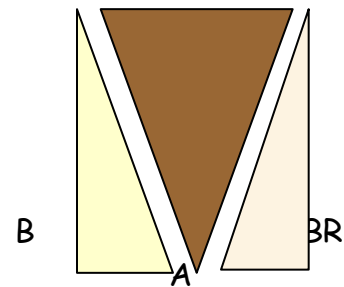
Triangle block - 68 needed

Trace and cut 68 tan triangles from template A

Cut 68 cream triangles from template B

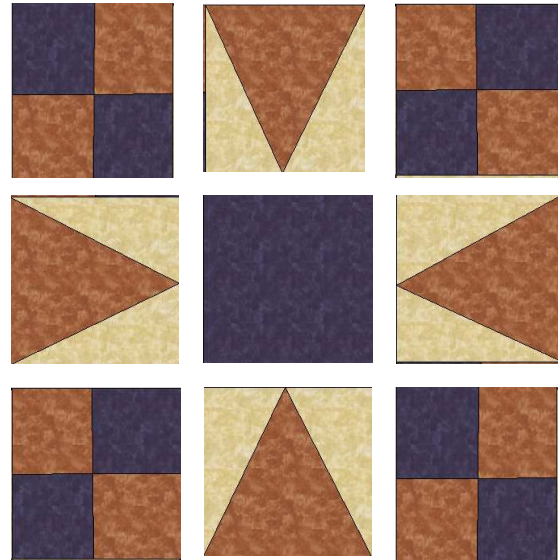
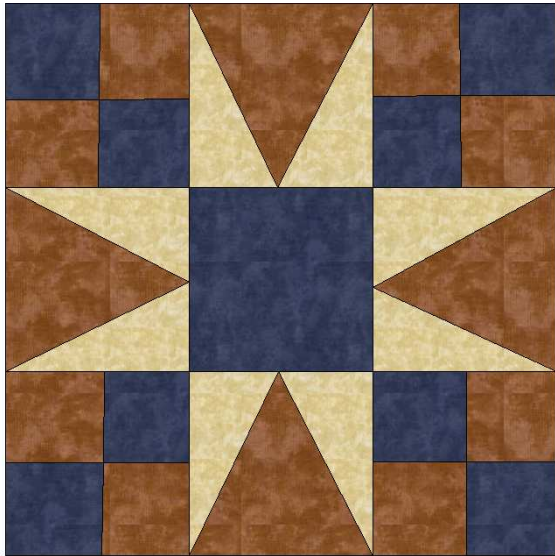
Cut 68 cream triangles from template BR

Sew together using the picture as a guide.



Center block - 17 needed

Cut 17 blue squares $3 \frac{1}{2}'' \times 3 \frac{1}{2}''$



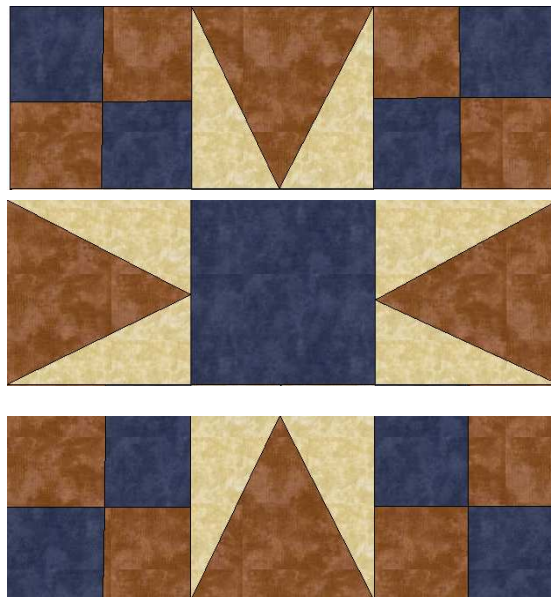
Follow picture for correct placement of blocks.

Row 1- Sew 1, 4-patch square to each side of
A triangle block.

Row 2 = Sew 1 triangle block to each side of a
blue center square.

Row 3 - - Sew 1, 4-patch square to each side of
A triangle block.

Sew rows together, press and square. Unfinished
Block size is $9 \frac{1}{2}$ ".



Block 2 Make 18 blocks

Finished size 9"

Half- square triangle block -72 needed

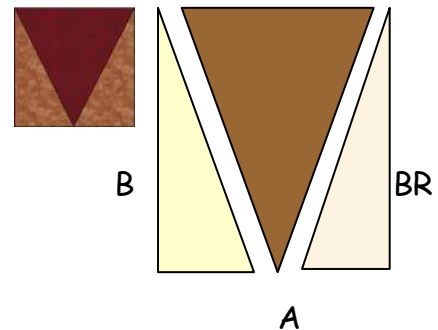


Cut 36 red squares $3 \frac{7}{8}'' \times 3 \frac{7}{8}''$ and 36 tan squares
Cut squares in half diagonally. Sew one tan and one red together
Press and square blocks. Finished size of half square block is 3"

Triangle block - 72 needed

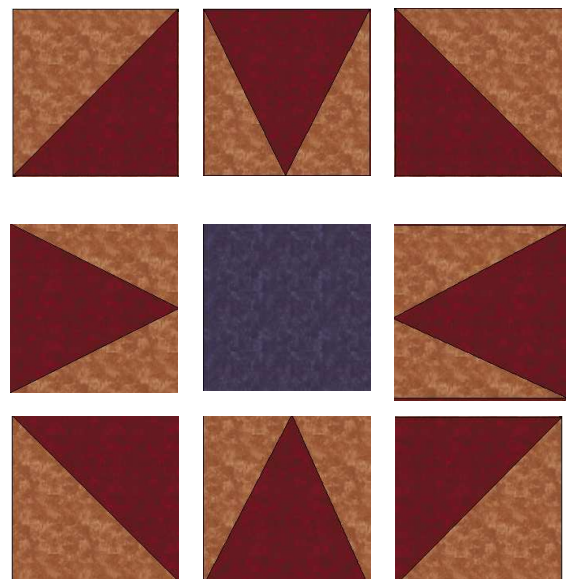
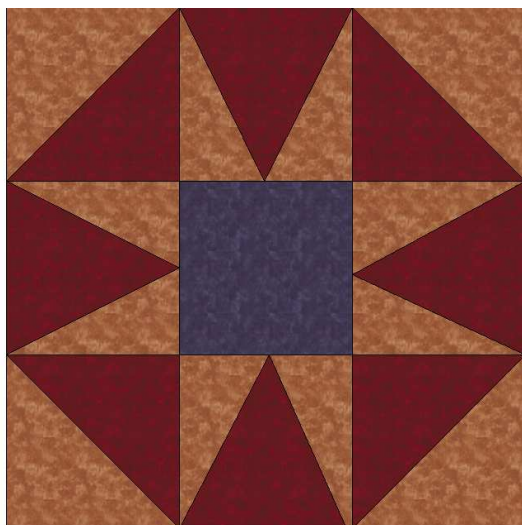
Trace and cut 72 red triangles from template A.
Cut 72 tan triangles from template B

Cut 72 tan triangles from template BR
Sew together using the picture as a guide.



Center block - 18 needed

Cut 18 blue squares $3 \frac{1}{2}'' \times 3 \frac{1}{2}''$



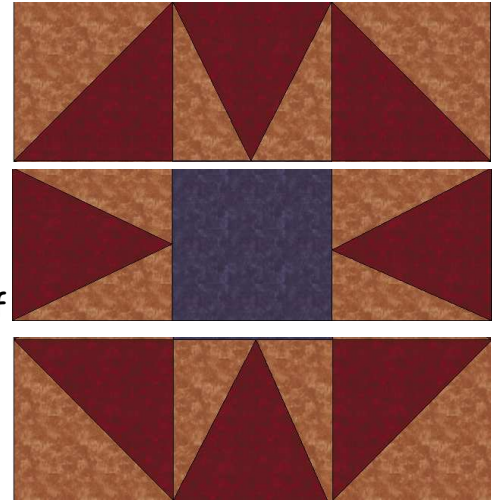
Follow picture for correct placement of blocks.

Row 1- Sew 1 half square triangle to each side of A triangle block.

Row 2 = Sew 1 triangle block to each side of a blue center square.

Row 3 - - Sew 1 half square triangle to each side of A triangle block.

Sew rows together, press and square. Unfinished Block size is 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

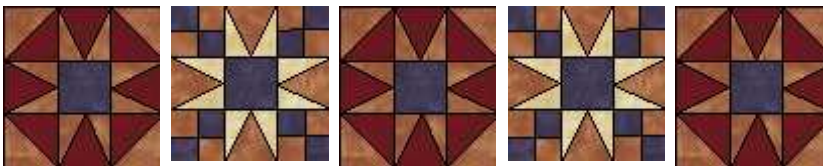


Putting it all together

Row A

Sew together block 2, block 1, block 2, block 1, block 2

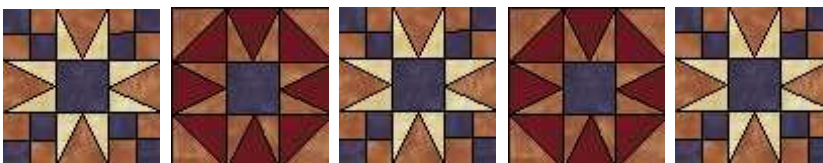
Rows 1, 3, 5 and 7



Row B

Sew together block 1, block 2, block 1, block 2, block 1

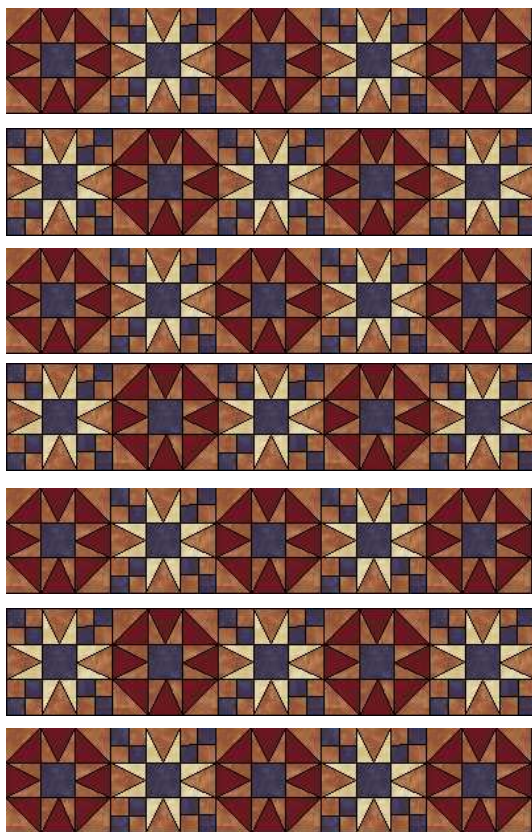
Rows 2, 4, and 6



Sew rows together alternating row A and B

Trim, press and square.

Top should measure $45 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $63 \frac{1}{2}$ "



Borders

Yardage amount given is for cutting strips across the width of fabric.

More fabric is needed for unpieced borders.

For accuracy measure your quilt across the center both vertically and horizontally.

1st Border

From Blue

Cut strips 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide

Side measurements are approximately 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Top and bottom are approximately 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Sew sides on 1st.

2nd Border

From Tan

Cut strips 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide

Side measurements are approximately 67 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Top and bottom are approximately 53 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Sew sides on 1

3rd Border

From Blue

Cut strips 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide

Side measurements are approximately 71 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Top and bottom are approximately 61 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Sew sides on 1st.
