

Bloomin Scraps



A quick and easy table runner .
Fabrics used – Scrapbook Garden from Moda

Finished size 30”x 18”

Fabric Yardage

1 yard tan print for center block and backing.
½ yard blue print for inside border and binding
28, 3.5” blocks in various prints for border
FQ green print for leaves
11” x 11” red print for flower
8” square of gold print for flower center

Center Square

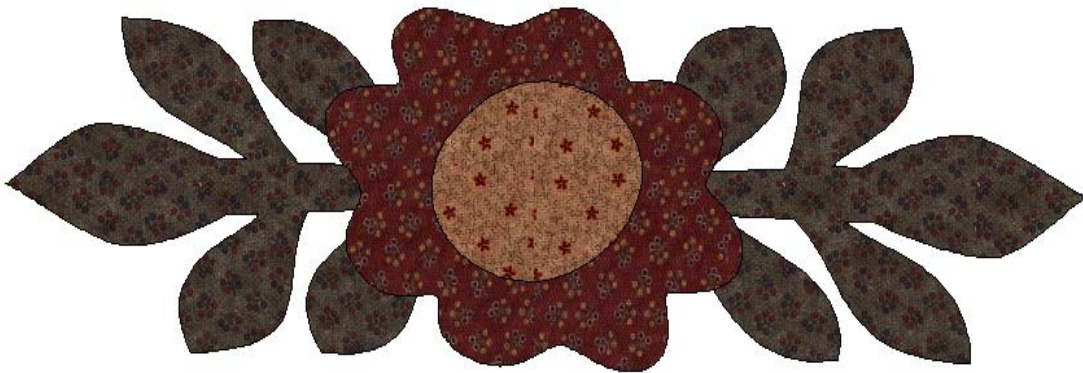
Cut tan fabric 10.5" x 22.5"

Use fusible web and follow the manufacturers instructions..

Iron the pattern piece to the tan fabric using the picture for placement.

Machine appliqué using a blanket stitch or zig-zag stitch.

For needleturn method be sure to add a seam allowance.



1st Border

Cut 2 strips of blue print 10.5" x 1.5" and sew to the sides of the center block

Cut 2 strips 24.5" x 1.5" and sew to the top and bottom of the center block.

Trim and press

2nd Border

Cut 28 – 3.5" squares from various prints.

Sew 4 squares together and sew to the right side.

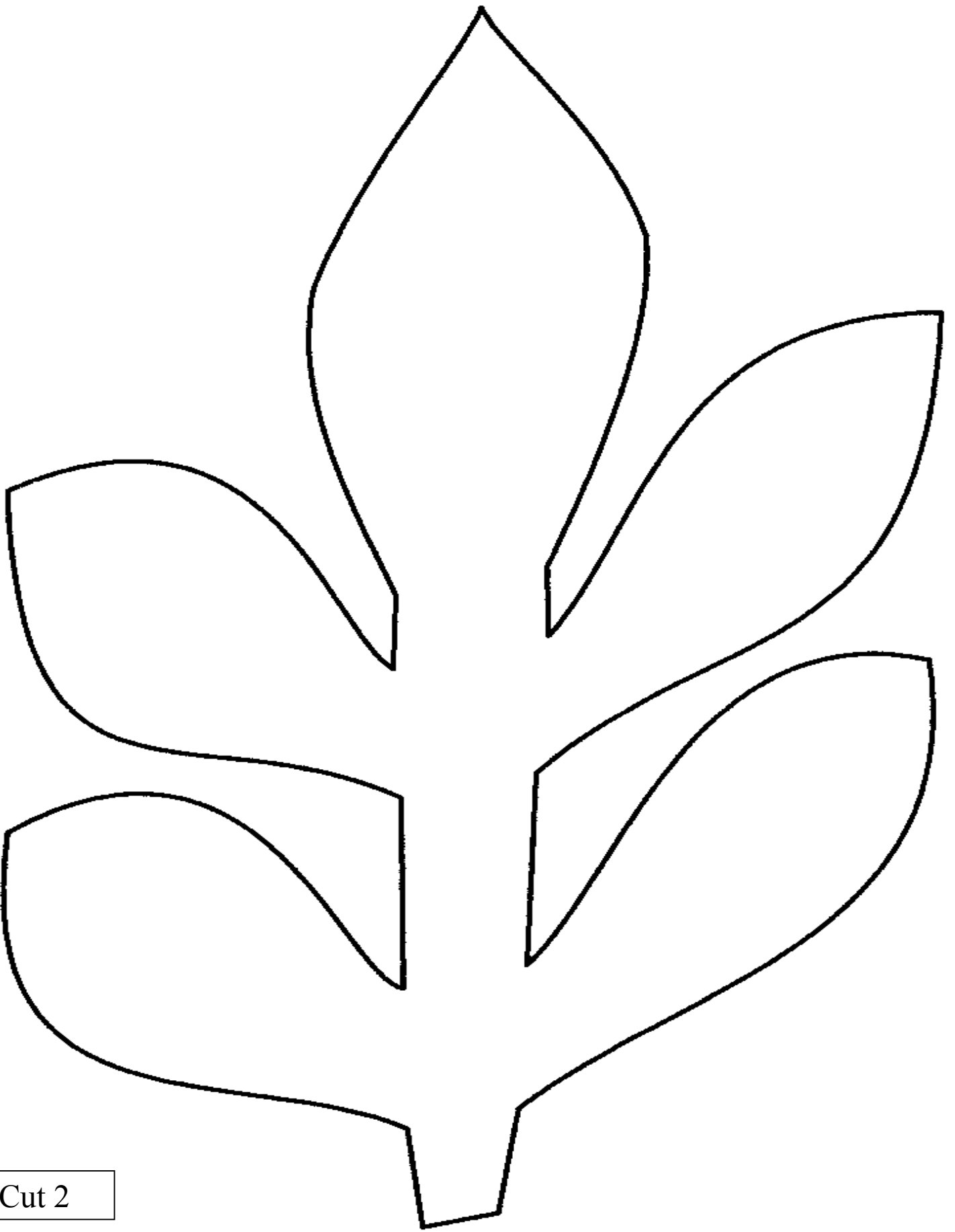
Repeat for the left.

For the top and bottom make 2 strips of 10 squares.

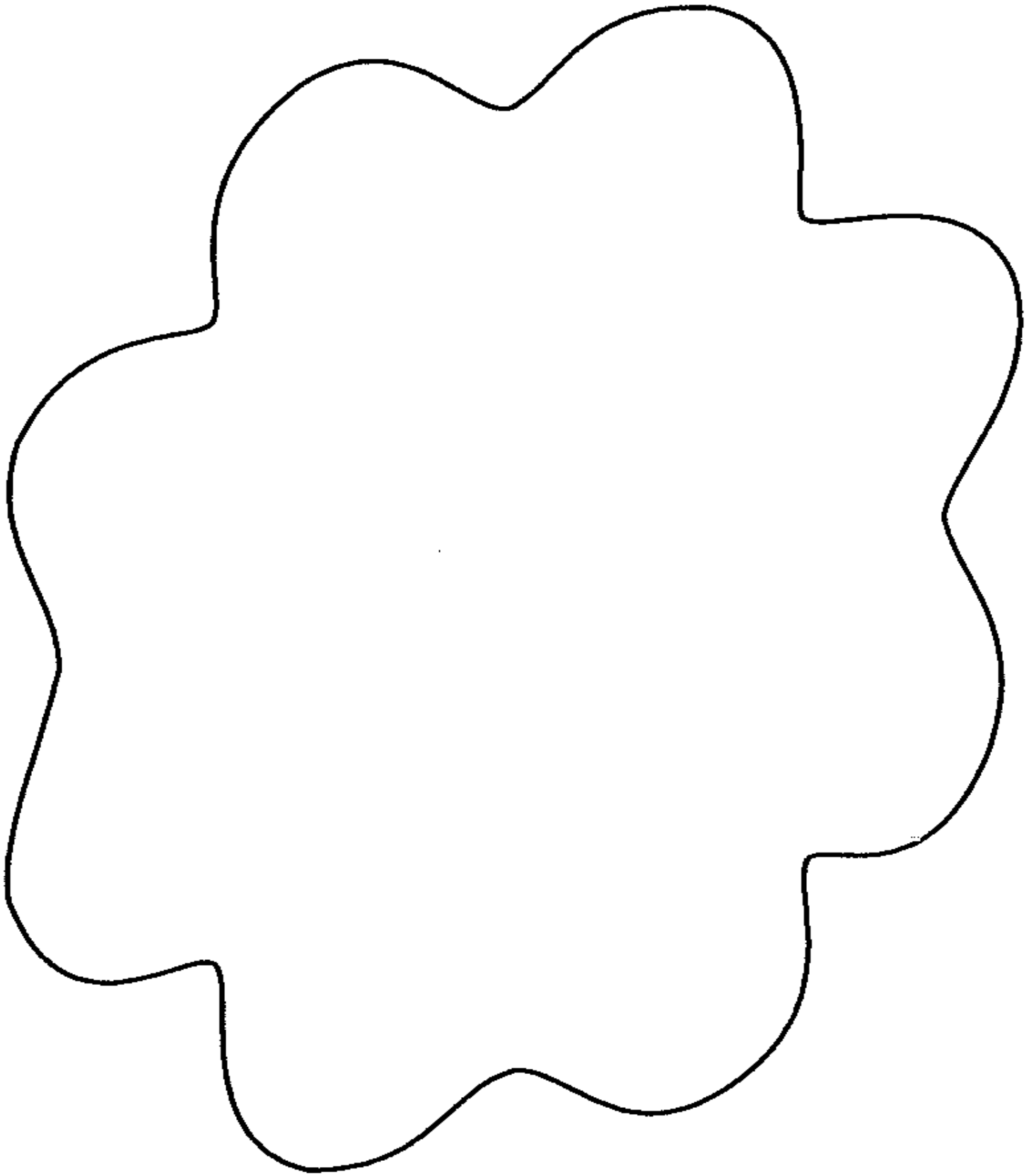
Trim and press

Layer quilt top, batting and backing.

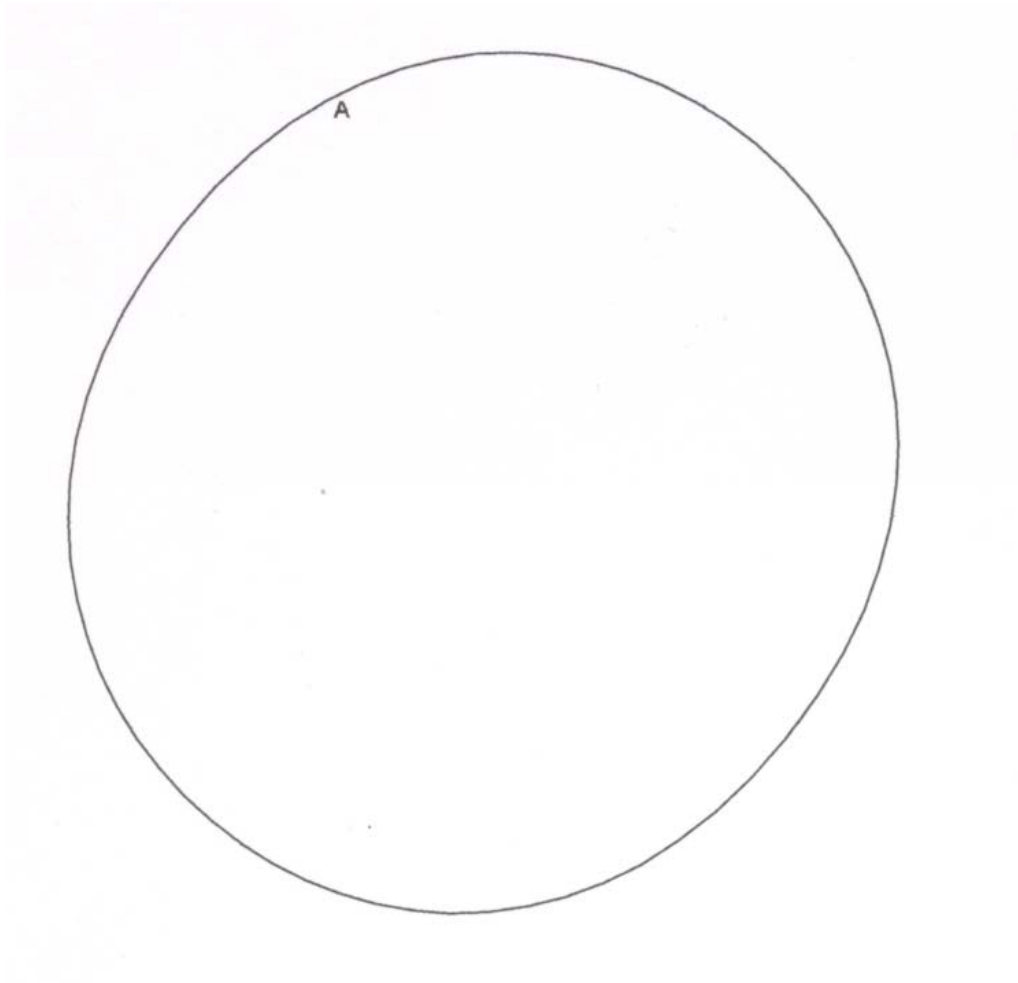
Quilt as desired and bind
