## Brittany's Star



Finished size 50" x50"

Buggy Barn II fabric by Henry Glass

### Fabric requirements

**Tan stripe**, 1 ½ yards for center appliqué , corner squares and half square triangles.

**Tan plaid** ½ yard for half square triangles

**Blue plaid** 1 ½ yards for 1<sup>st</sup> border, binding and appliques

**Blue floral** ¼ yard for flowers

**Red floral** ½ yard for appliqué flowers

**Red stripe** 1/8 yard for appliqué flowers and center circles

**Tan , red and blue print** 1 ¾ yards for out side borders

**Green** ¼ yard for flower stems

### **Unfinished Block Sizes**

**Center appliqué block** 18 ½”

**Half square triangles cut square** 9 7/8”

**Corner square** 9 ½”

### **Directions**

Cut 1 tan stripe 18 ½” x 18 ½” square for center appliqué.

For corners, cut 4 squares, that measure 9 ½” x 9 ½” each.

For half square triangles, cut two 9 7/8” squares from tan stripe and two 9 7/8” squares from tan plaid, then cut diagonally in half.

Sew 1 tan plaid and 1 tan stripe together on the diagonal. Finished square should measure 9 ½”.

Sew two of these blocks together, then sew each set of two blocks to the right and left sides of the center appliqué square. Make sure the plaid points are facing out.

For the top and bottom, sew one tan stripe applique square, to each side of the remaining half square triangle blocks . Repeat for the bottom.

Cut the inside border 2 ½” x the length and width of your quilt.

Cut the outside border 4 ½” x the length and width of your quilt.

Remember to measure across the center of your quilt for accurate border length and width.

For appliqué blocks use your preferred method and follow diagrams for placement. Seam allowances have not been added.
