

## Cabin Flowers

Finished size 60" x 60"

Limited number of kits are available



### Yardage

2 1/4 yards blue fabric for blocks, border and flowers

1 1/2 yards red fabric for blocks, flowers and border

7/8 yard of green #1 for blocks and leaves

1/4 yard of green #2 for leaves and vines

1 1/2 tan # 1 for center appliqué block and log cabin blocks

1/2 yard tan #2 for blocks

### Appliqué block

Cut tan # 1- 16 1/2" x 16 1/2" for center applique block.

Use fusible web and follow the manufacturers instructions.

Iron the pattern pieces to the background fabric using the picture for placement.

Machine appliqué using a blanket stitch or zig-zag stitch.

For needleturn method be sure to add a seam allowance.

\*Can also be appliquéd using wool



### Log Cabin Block

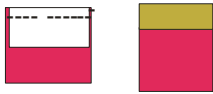
**Finished Block size 8"**

**32 blocks needed**

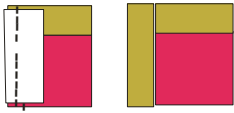
**Cut strips 1 1/2" wide x 9" long.**

**Trim after adding each strip**

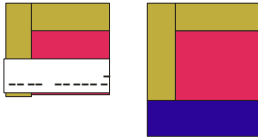
**Work counter clockwise (sorry I'm a lefty, lol)**



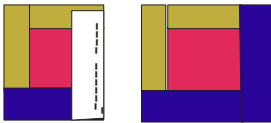
Start with a 2 1/2" dark square and sew a light strip to the top. Trim and square if needed.



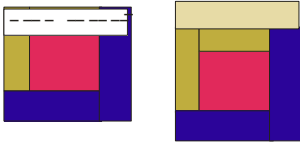
Working counter clockwise sew a light strip. Trim and square.



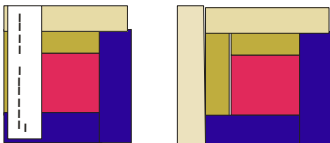
Continue in a counter clockwise direction and add a dark strip. Trim and square.



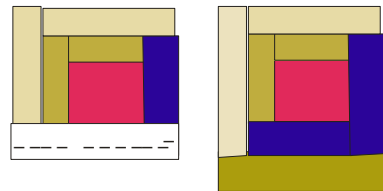
Add dark strip. Trim and square.



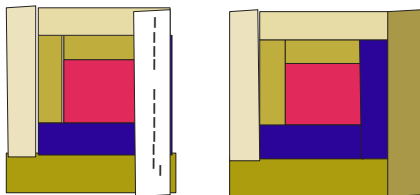
Next add a light strip. Trim and square.



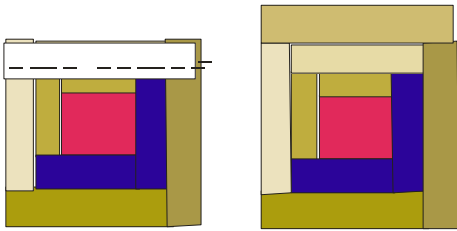
Next add a light strip . Trim and Square



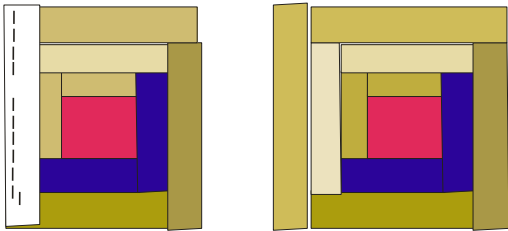
Continuing in a counterclockwise direction add a dark strip.



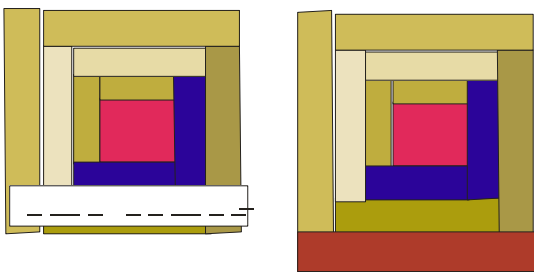
Next add another a dark strip. Trim and square



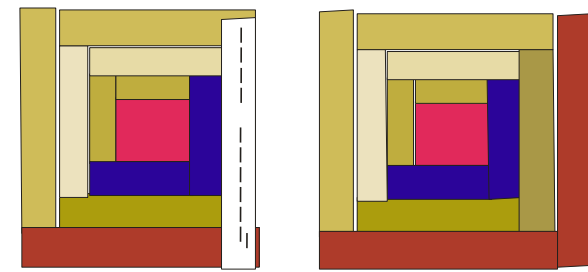
For the final round add a light strip.



Follow with adding another light strip



Next add a dark strip



.. And finally add a dark strip. Trim and square your block. It should measure 8 1/2" square.

### Assembling the quilt

Row 1

Sew 6 blocks together rotating each block to match the picture.

Square strip and press.



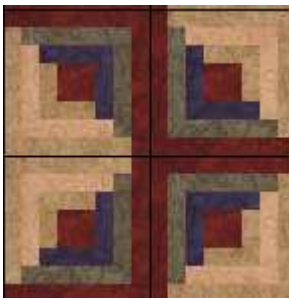
Row 2

Repeat for row 2

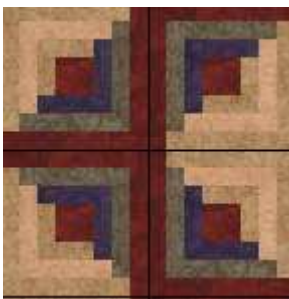


Rows 3 and 4

Because of the appliqué block rows 3 and 4 are done at the same time., Start by sewing 4 blocks together 2x.. One set of 4 will be for the left side of the appliqué block and the other set will be sewn on the right . Again follow the picture for block rotation. Trim and press.



Left side of appliqué block



Right side of appliqué block

Sew to each side of the appliqué block.



Row 5

Sew 6 blocks together rotating each block to match the picture.  
Trim and press.



Row 6

Repeat row 5 following the picture for the correct rotation of the blocks.



Square and press your quilt top.

### Borders

Cut border strips 5 1/2" wide.

Border strips will need to be pieced.

Measure the length and width through the center of your quilt.

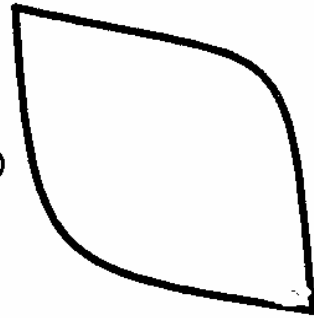
Remember to add seam allowance to the length

Approximate measurements are 58 1/2" long (sides) and 48 1/2" long (top and bottom)

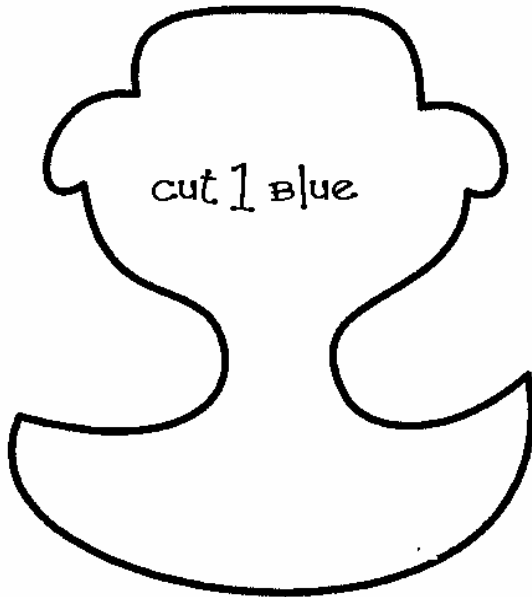
Layer quilt top, batting and backing.

Quilt and bind.

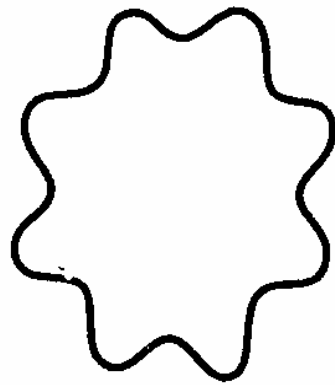
cut 5 red



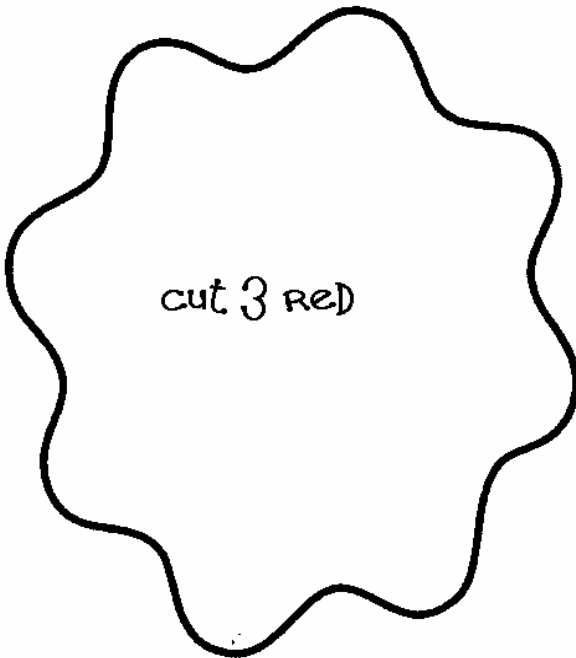
cut 1 blue
