

Cat On The Pumpkin

Size 20" x 24"



This is a fun pennyrug project to make.

It can be made using all fabric, wool and fabric or just wool.

If you use just wool, eliminate the outside squares and blanket stitch the tongues to the center appliqué rectangle.

Fabric Requirements

½ yard brown print

¾ yard dark tan print

¼ yard orange plaid for pumpkin and circles

FQ orange for pumpkin

FQ gold print for cornstalk

8.5" X 11" black plaid for cat

Embroidery floss

Center Rectangle

Cut center rectangle 12.5" x 16.5" (12 x 16 if using wool)
Applique pieces using embroidery or wool thread and a blanket stitch.
Follow the picture for placement of templates.

Hints

For fabric you can use Steam - a- Seam.

For wool you can use freezer paper.
Trace the design onto freezer paper. Iron the freezer paper to the wool and cut out design.
Remove paper and add a dab of fabric glue to hold in place while blanket stitching.



Out side border when using fabric

Cut 18 squares from brown print that measure 4.5" x 4.5".

Set aside 4 squares to use for corners.

Cut 14 circles and 14 tongues.

Blanket stitch 1 circle to each tongue.

Blanket stitch 1 tongue to each of the 14 squares, making sure the raw edges are even.

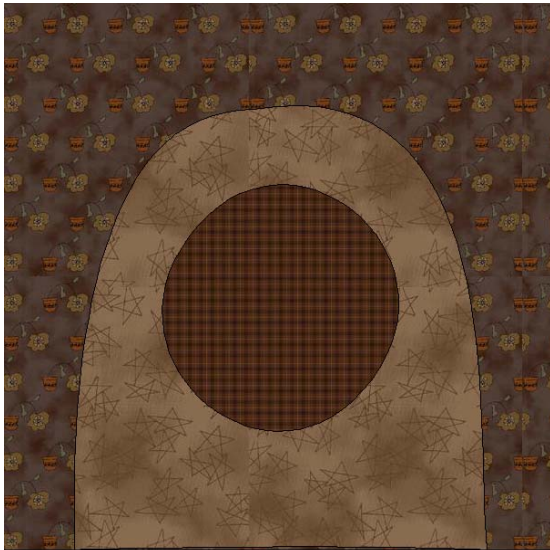
Using 1/4" for your seam allowance, sew 4 tongue squares together and sew to the left side of the appliqué rectangle.

Repeat for the right side.

Sew 1 plain square, 3 tongue squares and 1 plain square together for the top.

Repeat for the bottom.

Bind using your usual method.



*****Directions for using wool*****

Eliminate the brown print fabric

Cut 14 tongues from wool and 14 from the backing fabric.

Blanket stitch the circles to the 14 wool tongues.

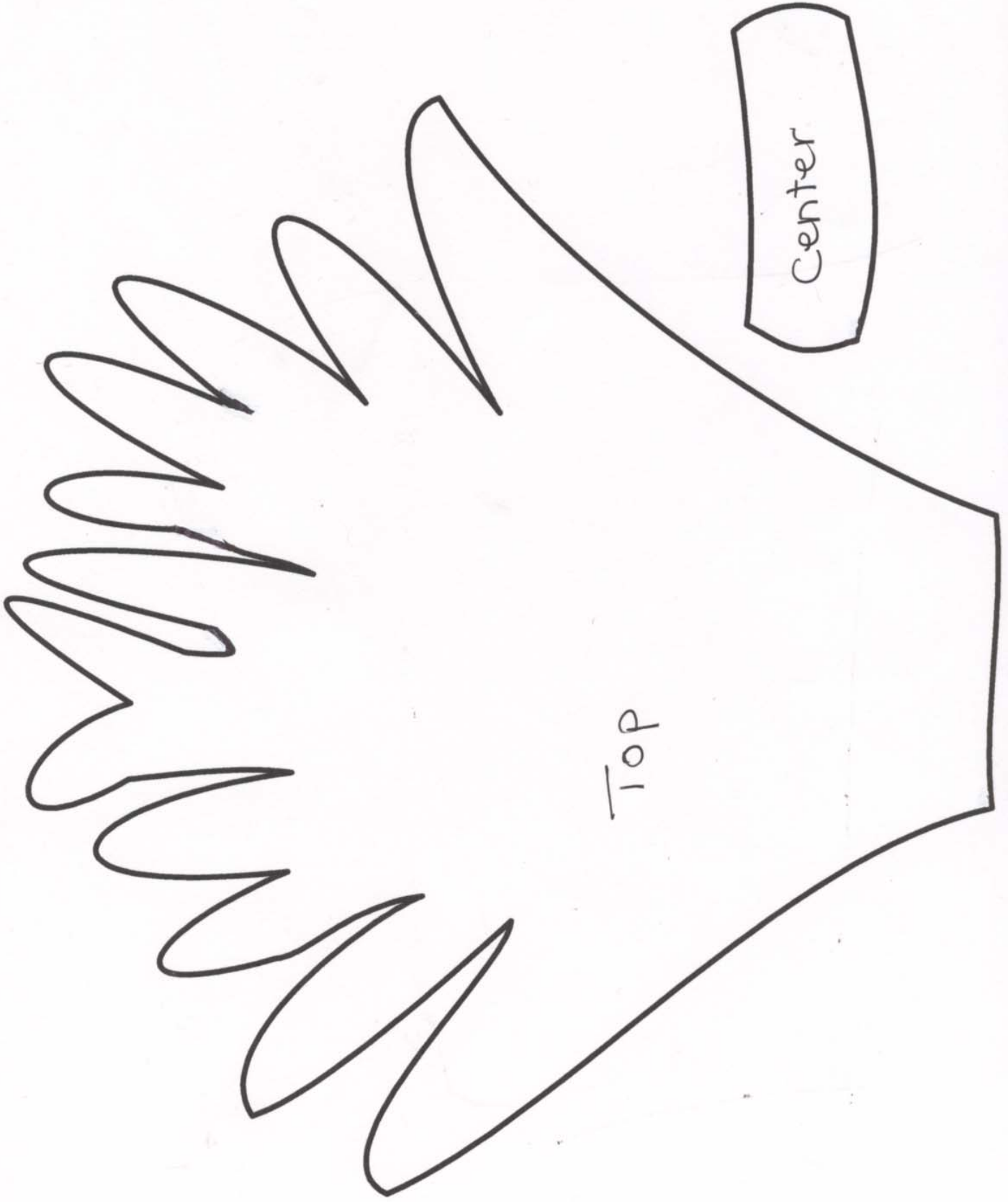
Join 1 circle tongue and 1 backing tongue together by blanket stitching around the outside.

Cut backing the size of the center rectangle.

Blanket stitch around the outside attaching the tongues using the picture for placement.

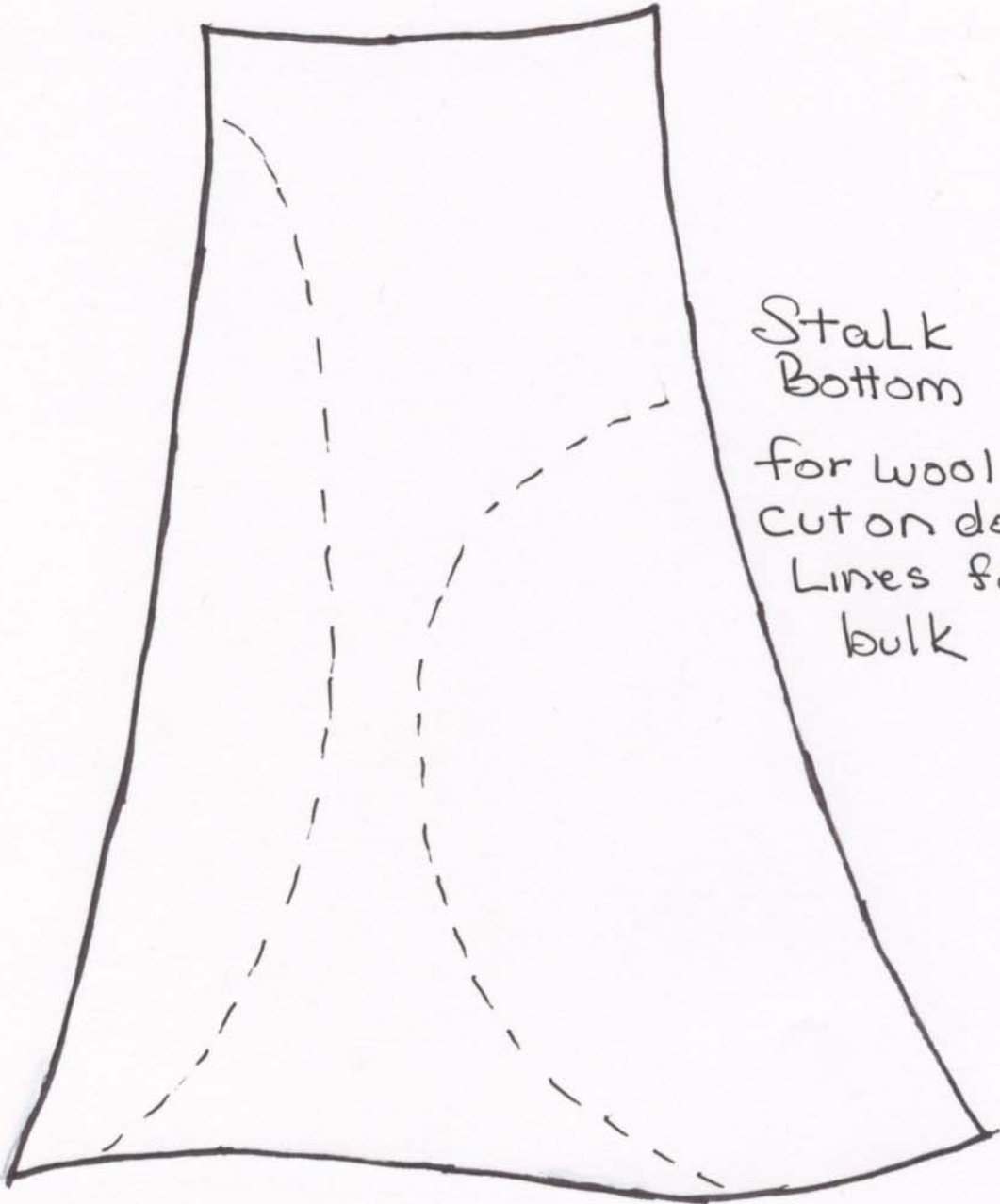
Suggestions for backing – wool, flannel, homespun, Sandcastle, Prairie Cloth
