Fabric Yardage

fq red for stripes
fq beige for stripes
fq dark tan for appliqué block
fq red print for flowers
fq blue print for flowers
fq's of 2 greens for leaves and stems
fq gold print for flower circles and star
 $\frac{3}{4}$ yard blue plaid for borders and binding
1 piece of blue for star square that is at least 4.5" x 4.5"
6" x 6" black print for vase

Flag directions

For the flag cut 4 strips that measure 1.5" x 10.5"

Sew together in the following order, red, white, red, white

Cut a 4.5 x 4.5 square from the blue piece of scrap fabric for the star square.

Sew the 4.5 blue square to the left side of the strip.

Sew 3 strips together that measure 1.5" x 14.5" red, white, red

Sew to the top portion of the flag.

Applique gold star to the center of the blue square.

Applique block.

Cut background 14.5" x 18"

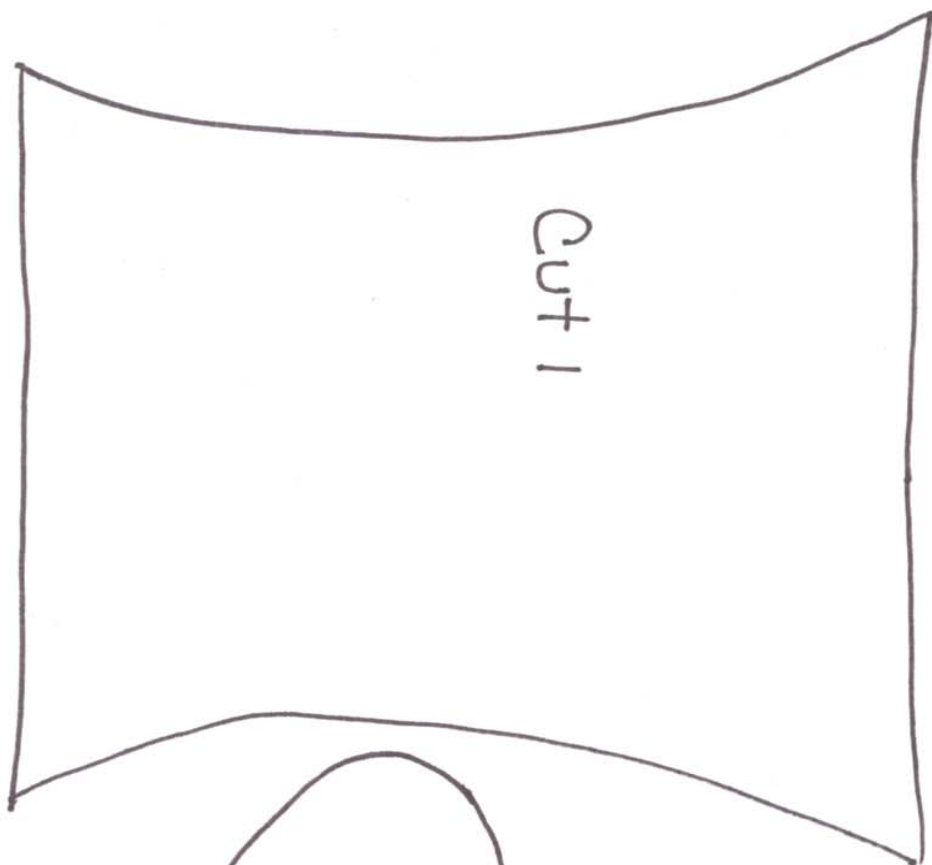
Using your favorite method of appliqué, follow the picture for placement of the pieces. I like to use Steam A Seam and machine appliqué.

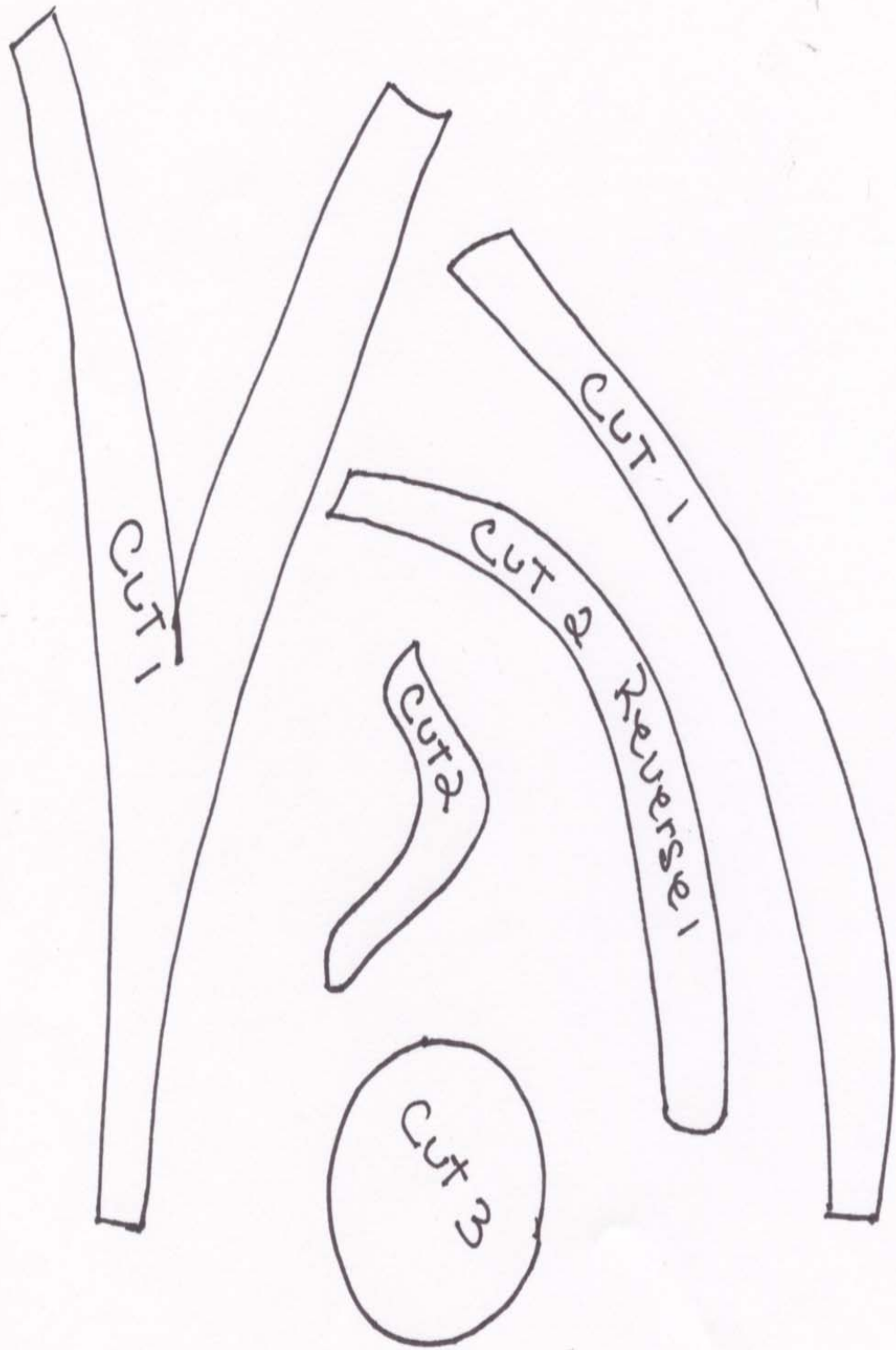
Cut 2.5" wide strips for border

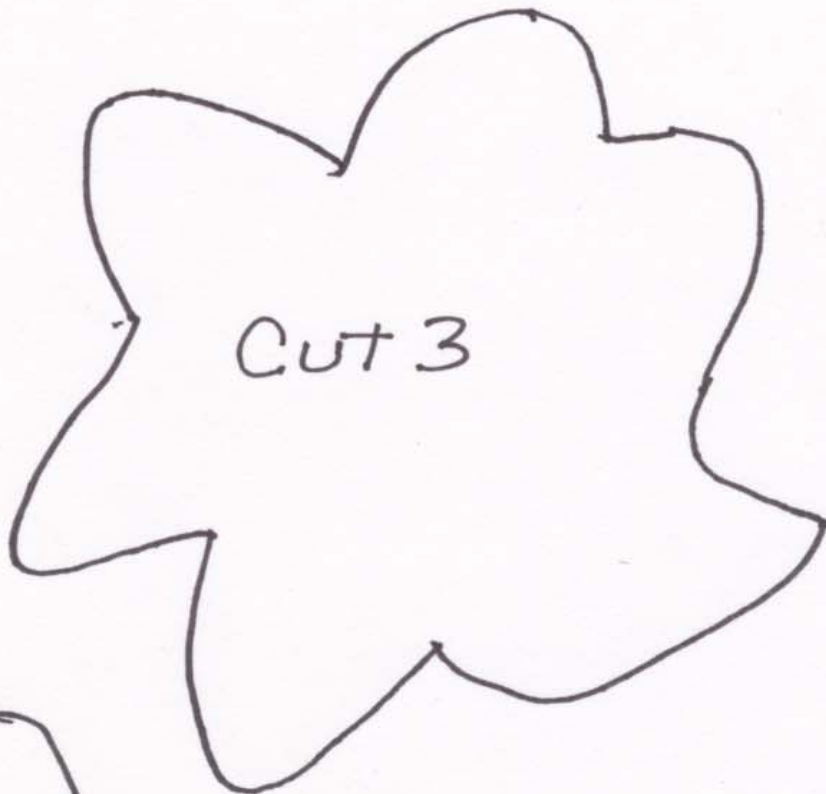
Bind using your favorite method



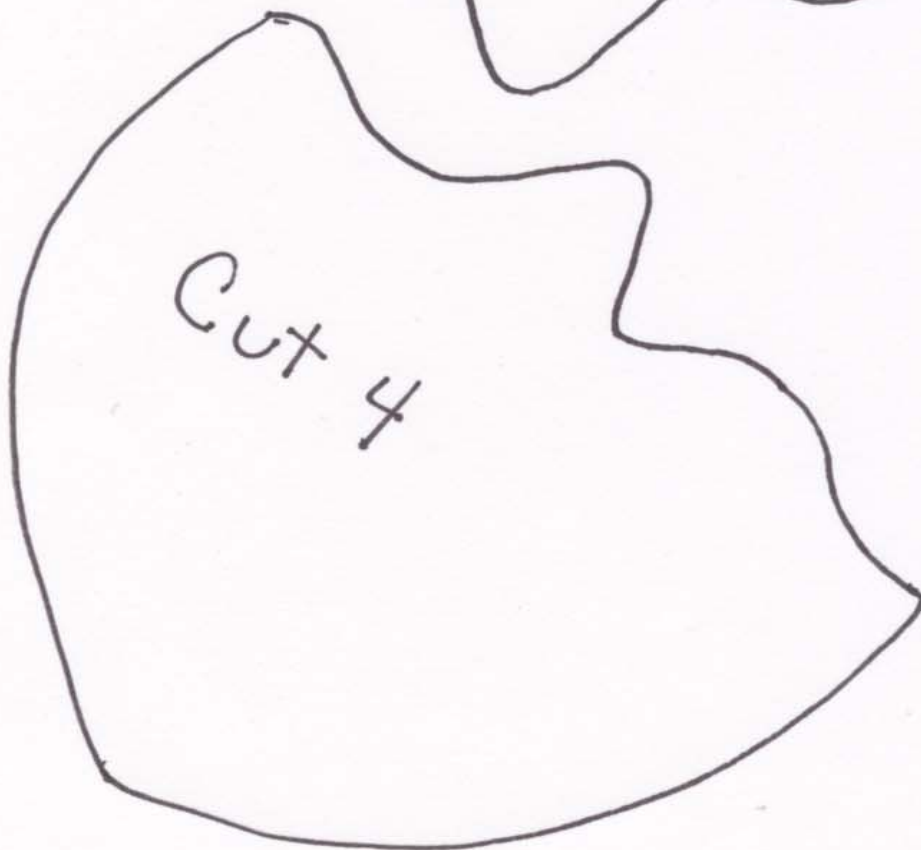
