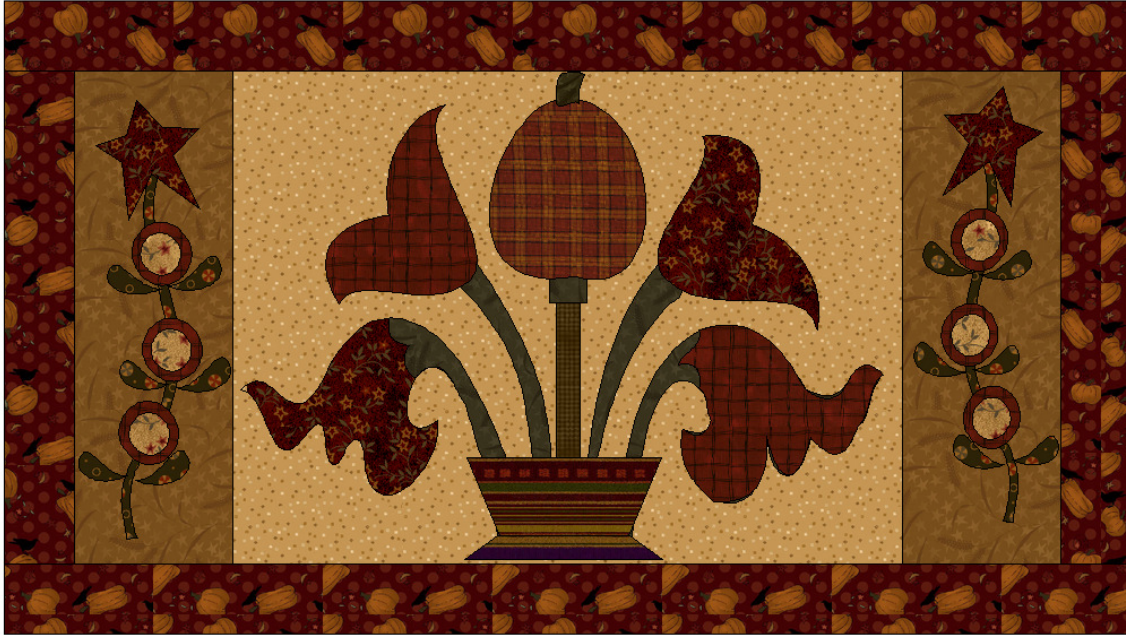


Finished size 34"x20"



This is a great project for using fall color scraps.

Fabric Requirements

- Fat Quarter of Beige for center square
- 5" strip of Tan for side strips
- 6" x 6" square of Orange Plaid for pumpkin
- 6" Strip of Red 1 for flowers and stars
- 6" strip of Red 2 for flowers and circles
- 1/8 yard Green 1 for leaves and vines
- 1/8 yard Green 2 for stems
- 7" x 7" Stripe for vase
- Scraps Brown for bobbin
- 3" x 15" Beige for flower center
- 1/3 yard Pumpkin print for border and binding

Cut center square $19 \frac{1}{2}'' \times 15 \frac{1}{2}''$

Sew 1 - $5'' \times 14 \frac{1}{2}''$ tan strip to each side.

Trace appliqué designs on to fusible web. Follow manufacturers instructions . Use the picture for placement of the appliqué pieces.

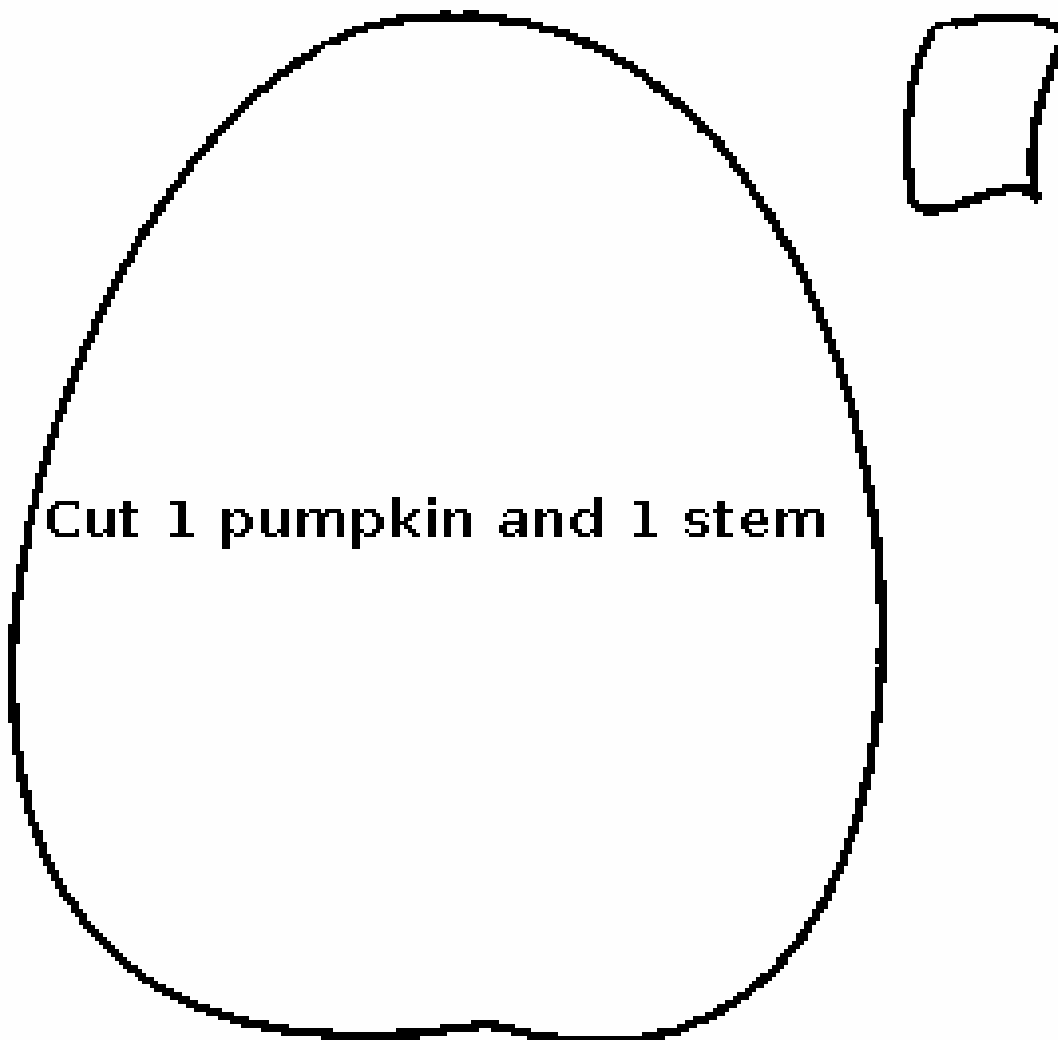
Applique using hand or machine blanket stitch.

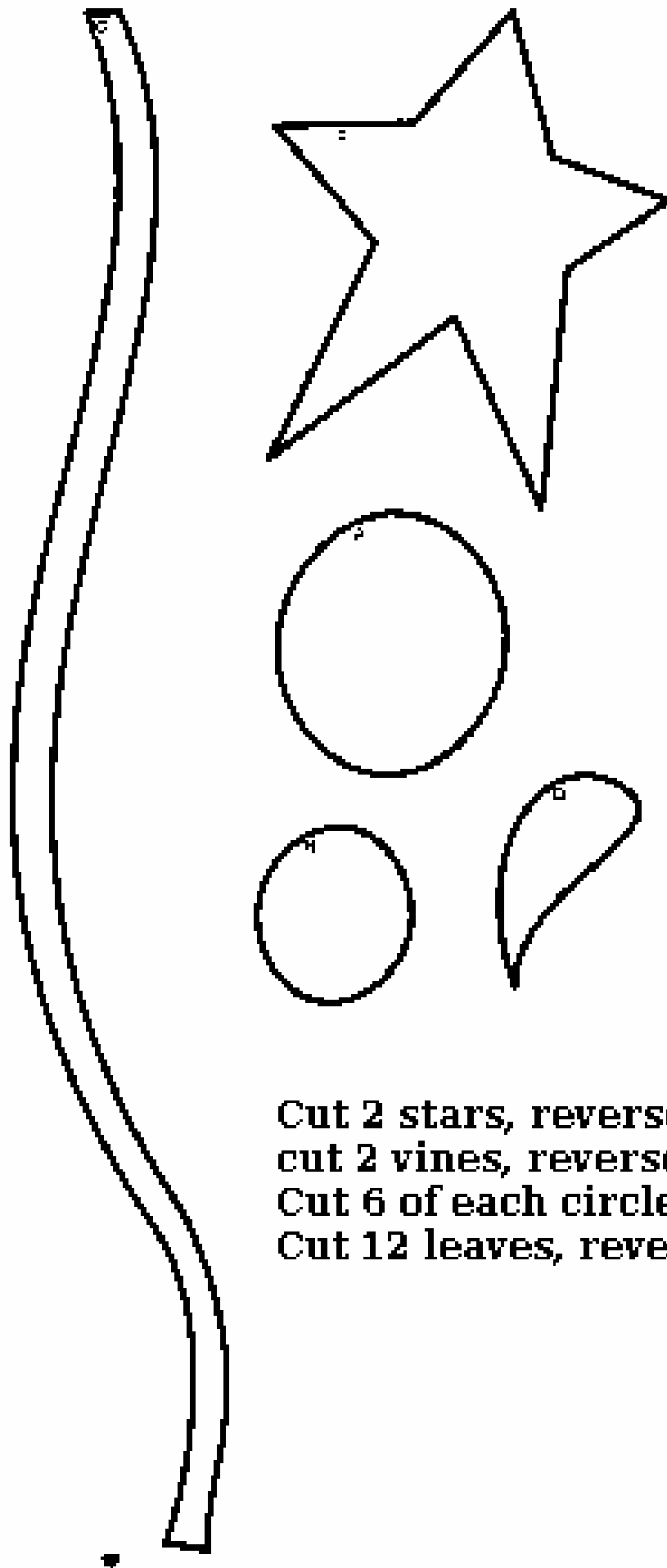
Remember to add $\frac{1}{4}''$ if you prefer the needleturn method.

For the border cut 2 strips $2 \frac{1}{2}'' \times 14 \frac{1}{2}''$ for each side.

Cut 2 top and bottom pieces $2 \frac{1}{2}'' \times 32 \frac{1}{2}''$.

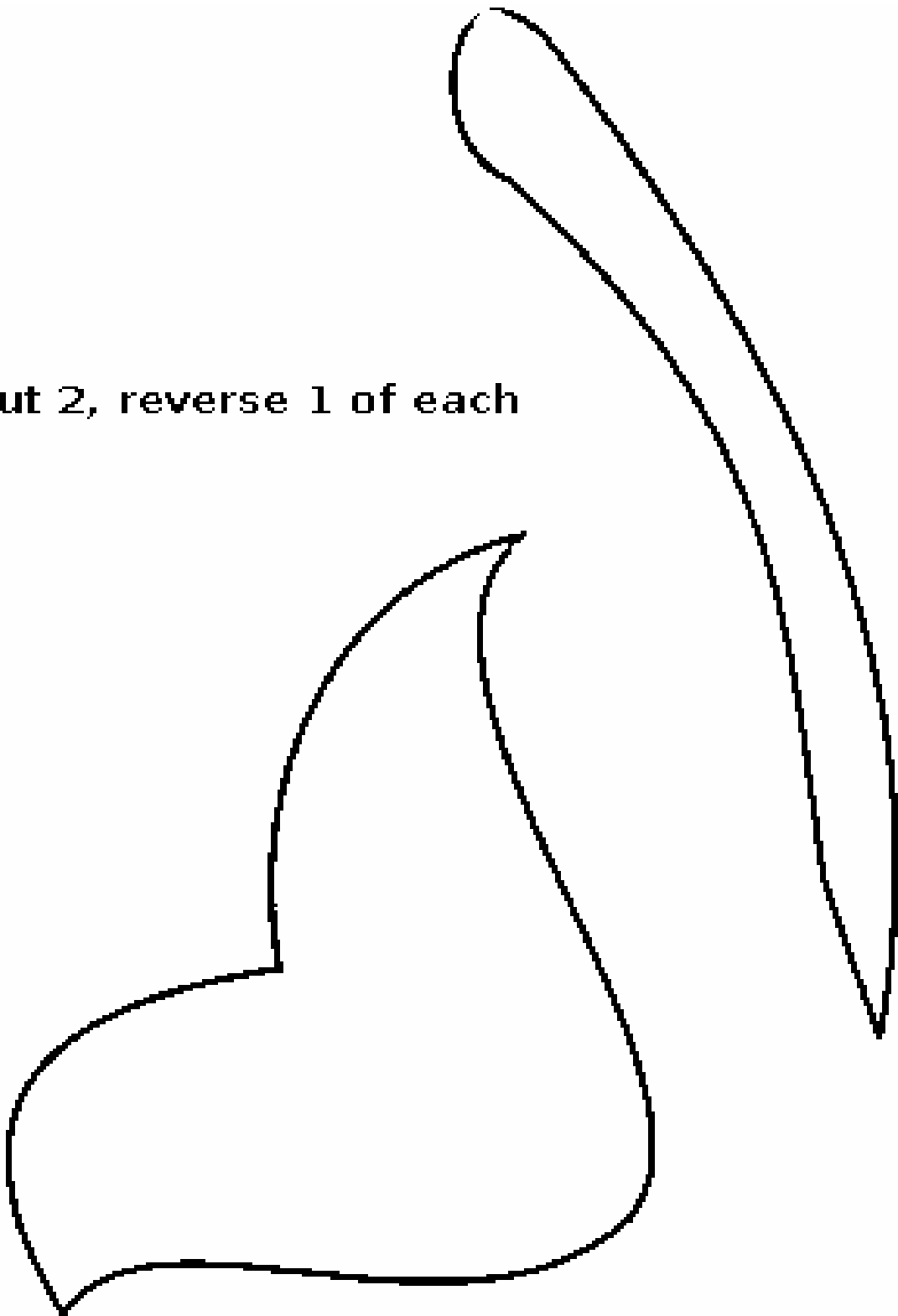
Bind.





**Cut 2 stars, reverse 1
cut 2 vines, reverse 1
Cut 6 of each circle
Cut 12 leaves, reverse 6**

Cut 2, reverse 1 of each



Cut a total of 2 each
reverse 1 each
