

Penny's Penny

Finished size 29" x 13.5"



Wool Requirements

- 27" x 13.5" Tan wool for rug base and bones
- 9" x 7" Red wool
- 9" x 13" Green wool for leaves
- 9" x 9" Brown wool dog
- 6" x 5" brown for dog ear and cat paw
- 7" x 9" Black wool cat and tail
- 4" piece of Gold wool for cat's eye and nose.
- 10" x 10" Red plaid wool for tongues
- 10" x 10" White wool for hat tassles and hat band
- 22.5" x 13.5" Wool or flannel for backing
- Floss for blanket stitching

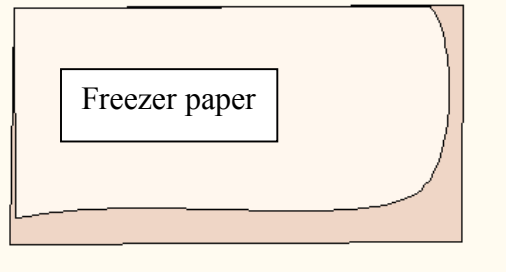


Directions

Cutting the base and backing. Cut the base and the backing 22.5" x 13.5". Remainder is for the bones.
 Fold the 22.5" x 13.5" piece of tan wool in half. This will give you an 11.25" x 13.5" piece. Starting at the top, fold downward in half again. This will give you an 11.25" x 6.75" piece.
 Trace pattern piece "A" on to freezer paper. Cut out and iron on to folded wool and trim.

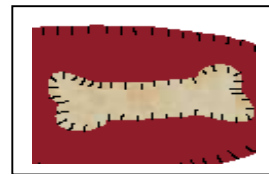

Arrange pieces on tan wool following the picture for placement.
 Use a dab of fabric glue to hold pieces in place.
 Applique using embroidery floss and a blanket stitch around all the pattern pieces.

Tongues

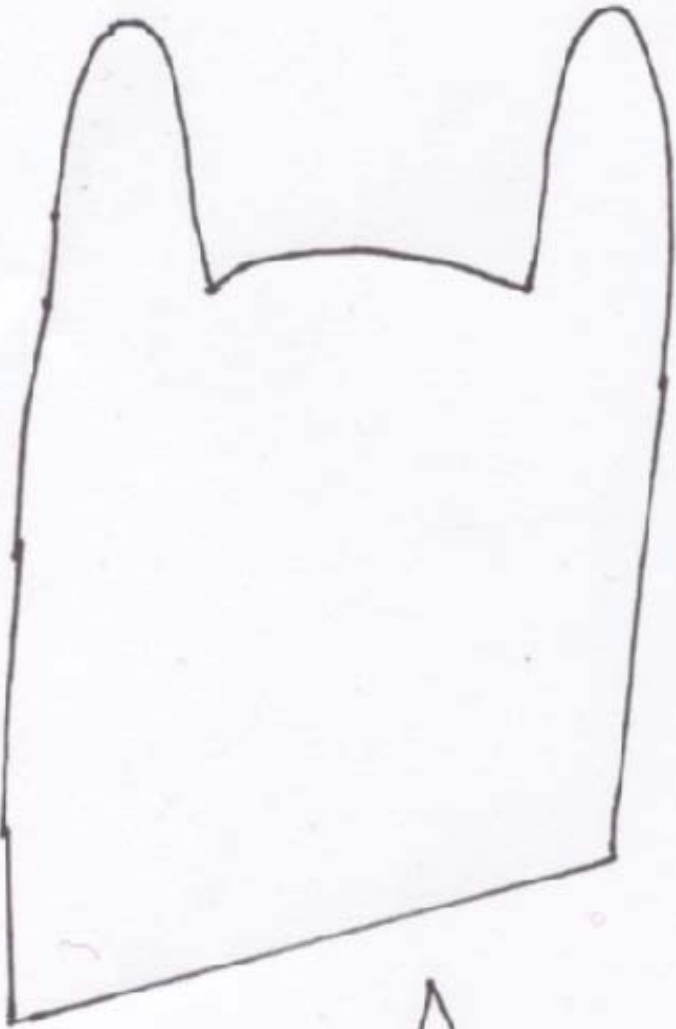
Cut 12 tongues
 Cut 6 bones and blanket stitch to 6 of the tongues.
 Layer 1 bone tongue and 1 plain tongue.
 Blanket stitch around the out side of tongues.




Finishing

Layer backing and top right sides out
 Blanket stitch around the outside attaching the tongues as you go.
 Refer to the picture for placement.

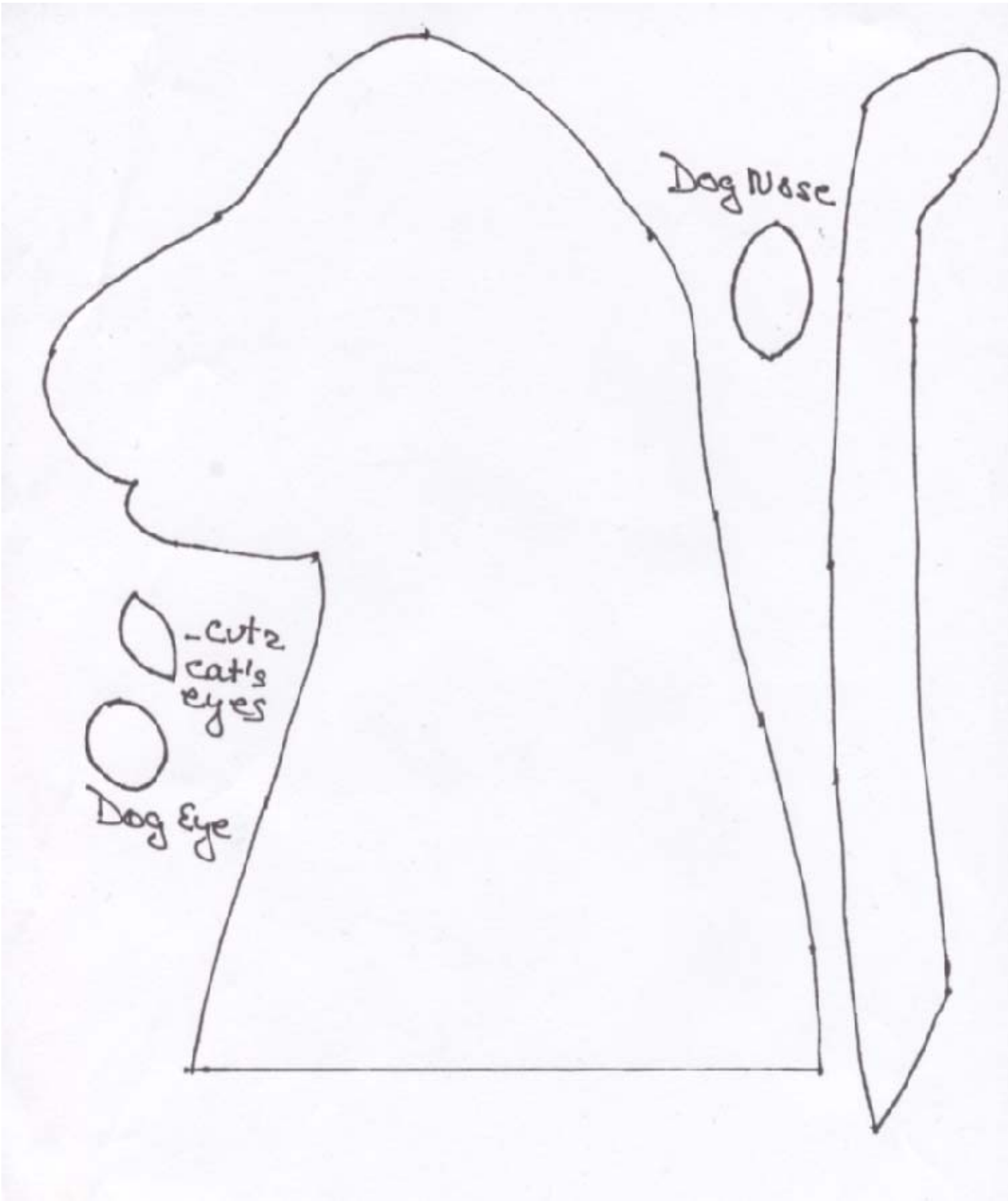
