Plaid Pad

Finished size 26" x 34"



Fabric Requirements

- 5/8 yard of various dark and medium plaids
- 1/2 yard of tan plaid or print for appliqué block
- FQ gold for stars, door and flower centers.
- 1/2 yard of dark plaid or print for inside border, roof, and binding.

Center Applique Block

Cut tan fabric 14 ½" x 22 ½"

Cut dark plaid rectangle 10" x 5" for the house.

Cut 4 tan windows 1 ½" x 1"

Cut 2 tan windows 2" x 1"

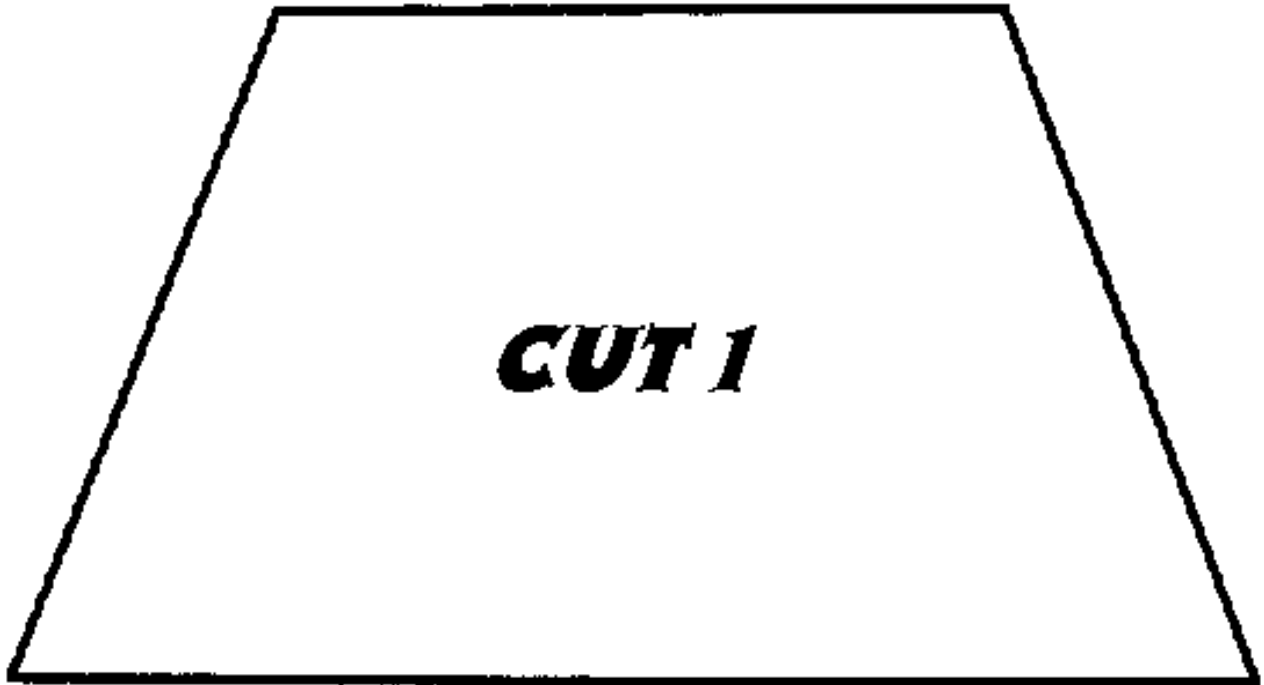
Cut 2 plaid rectangles 1 ½" x 1" for chimney's

Cut 1 gold rectangle for the door 1" x 3"

Refer to the picture for placement

Remember to add seam allowances for needleturn method.

Templates for House



Inside border

Cut 3 strips of border print 1 1/2" wide by width of fabric.

Cut one strip in half and sew 1 strip to the top and 1

Strip to the bottom of the appliqué block.

Trim.

Sew 1 strip to each side. Trim and square

Outside Border Blocks

Unfinished block size is 4 1/2" square

Cut 16 plaid squares measuring 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

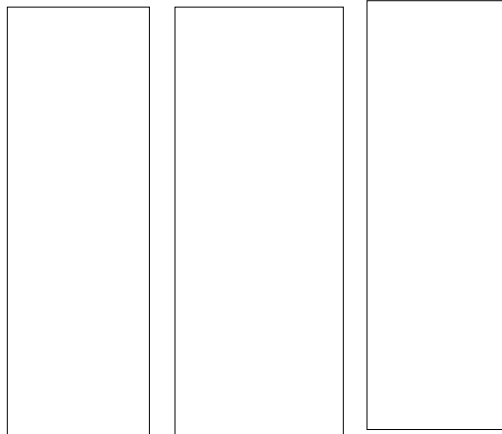
Make 2 tree trunk blocks

Cut 4 dark strips measuring 4 1/2" x 1 3/4"

Cut 2 medium color strips measuring 4 1/2" x 2"

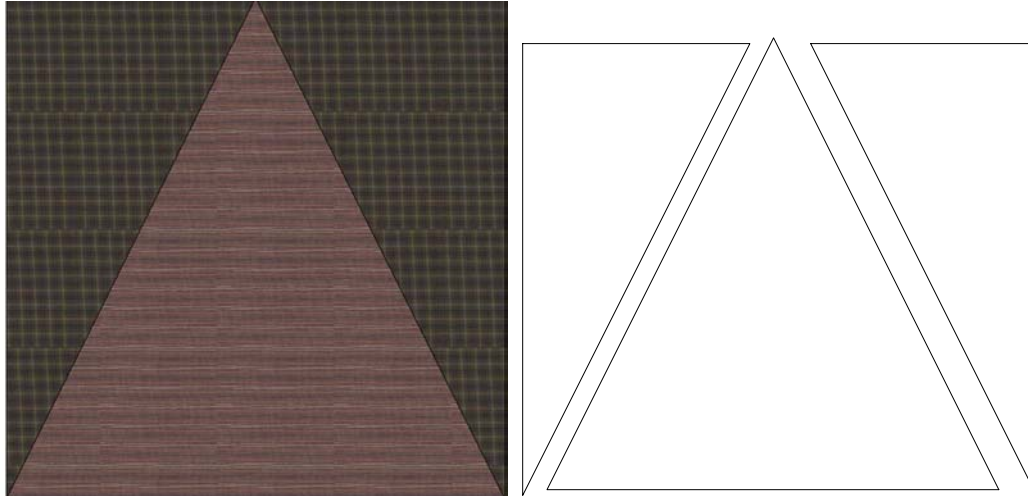
for the center strip.

Sew together as shown.



Triangle Blocks

Make 6 triangle blocks using the templates provided and following the diagram



Border Construction

Make 2 strips of 4 plaid squares and sew 1 each to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

For the left side border sew 3 triangle squares, 1 tree trunk and 4 plaid squares together to form a vertical strip. Sew to the left side.

For the right side border sew 4 plaid squares, 3 triangle and 1 tree trunk square together to form a vertical strip and sew to the right side of the quilt top.

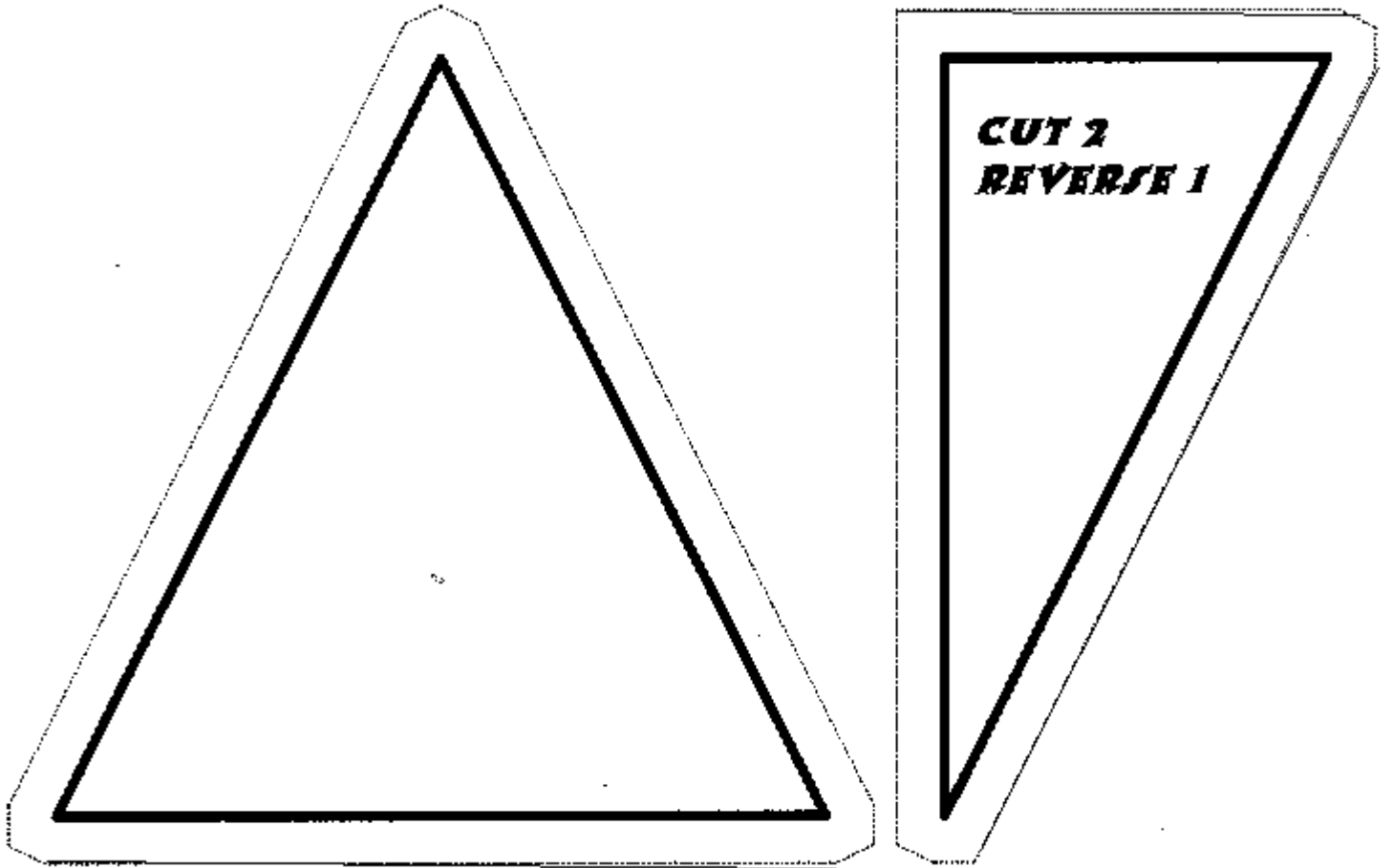
Trim and square quilt.

Binding

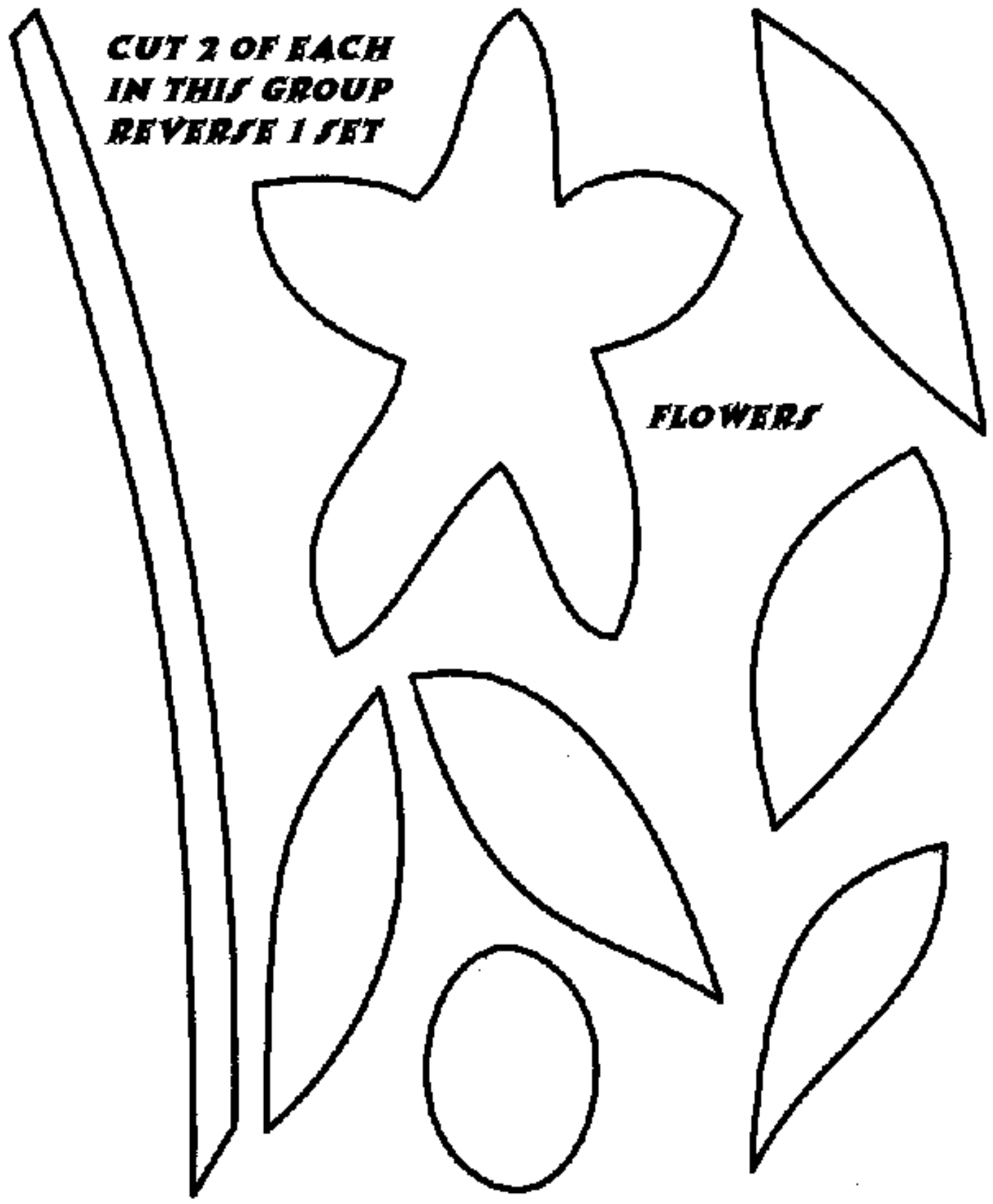
Cut binding 1 ¾" wide for single fold.

Quilt as desired and enjoy!

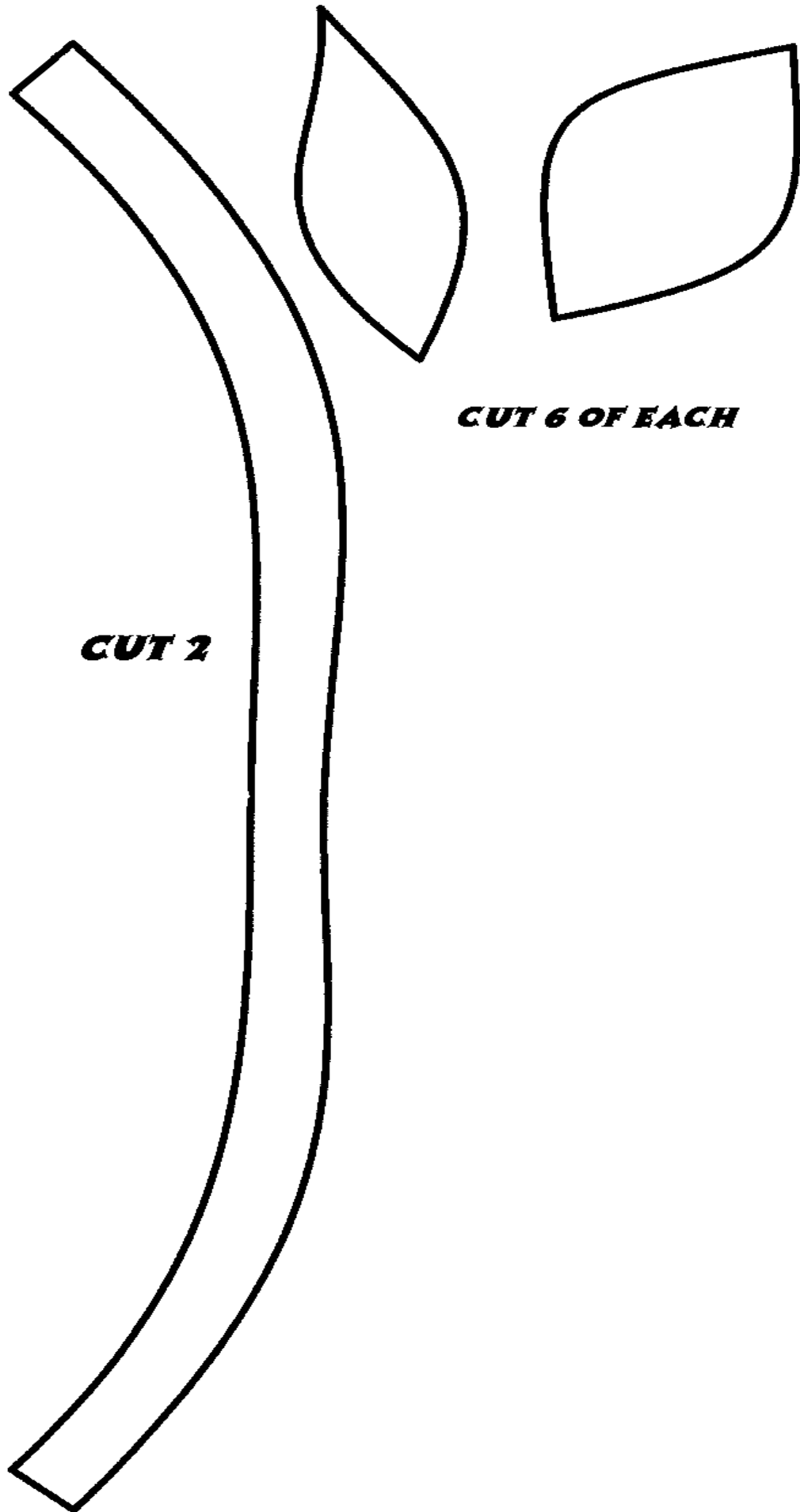
Triangle Block Templates

REVERSE 1 SET**

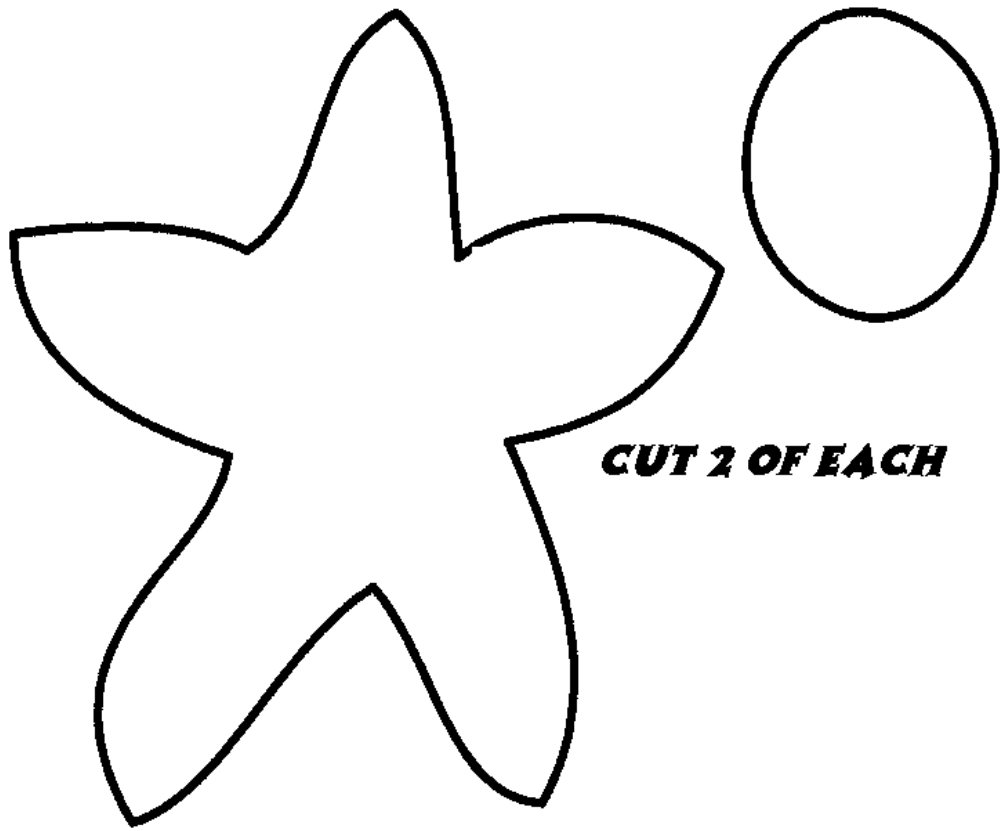
